In general, comments of Annual Report for Yarpole with Croft can be read for Lucton

In particular the following concern Lucton.

The planning application for development of ten homes finely resolved with a refusal, was due in no small measure by the number of objections from Lucton residents ,the adoption of the NDP and the lobbying of the Parish council and Sebastian Bowen .(District councillor)

BT completed the work on broadband connection, with some initial problems ,now sorted.

Speeding in village and junction with B4362 remain a problem . At a meeting in Feb. with BBLP various suggestions were talked through eg. A traffic calming order ,initiated by Parish Council and further slow signs at junction. The PC have included money in reserves plan to assist with speed reduction and safety.

Council received notice that a 30mph limit would apply to the U9204, Stocking Lane.

Lucton has been well represented by its councillors. Planning applications relating to Lucton have been well researched by Clr Trotter, and his diligence has helped with Council's decisions.
