10. Jeff Woodfield. Current scheme - involves widening the lane (on west), which we would oppose, and the layout does not reference or represent the massing that characterises the historic part of the village. Kate presented a number of alternative ideas for the layout of and access to the site.

The steering group re-emphasised that they support the development of this site.

18. Brook House Farm has had a response from Hereford Planning for their draft proposals. They have said that they are now going ahead with a full planning application. We have a meeting scheduled with them tomorrow (1st April 17.00 hrs - present, Kate, Audrey and Brian) to discuss the application.
